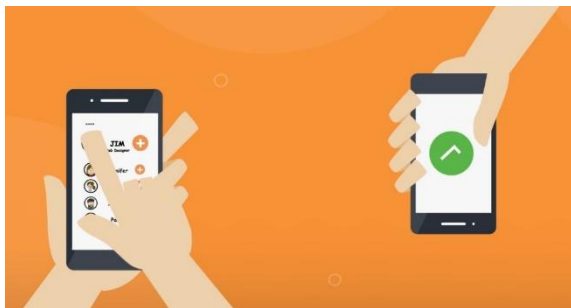
Go to the 'Events' tab and search for **2017 AGLS Annual Meeting**
