Examples of a Snapshot might be best practices in administration, specific elements of a GenEd program, or intriguing courses. Snapshots are not to be descriptions of full scale program or curriculum revisions, or about how an entire GenEd program works.

How to Submit a Snapshot

- ➤ Snapshot should be no more than 500 words
- ➤ Include a name, email and phone number of the person to contact for more information regarding your GenEd program
- ➤ Include the URL for your campus
- ➤ Include the URL for your GenEd program
- ➤ Include any graphics or photos you would like us to include with the story (.jpeg or .png format preferred)
